INSTRUCTION MANUAL

MAZEL TOV!

You are the owner of the revolutionary KosherLamp™ MAX brand shabbos lamp™. Soon you will be bringing more light to your Shabbat and Yorn Tov.

Before operating your lamp, please read the following safety, installation, operation and halachic (Jewish Law) instructions.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION:

- **DO NOT operate near flammable gas or liquids.**
- **DO NOT immerse in water.**
- **Do not immerse in water**
- **TO reduce risk of electric shock or fire, remove plug from the wall socket when changing the bulb.**
- **Do not use if the compact fluorescent bulb is broken. It is a fire hazard.**
- **In the event your lamp falls, please ensure that the bulb is intact before using.**
- **For environmental reasons, please dispose used bulbs as you would used batteries.**
- **DO NOT USE A REGULAR INCANDESCENT OR HALOGEN BULB. THEY WILL OVERHEAT.**



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Plug cord into the wall socket. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. DO NOT attempt to defeat this safety feature.
2. Turn the top until the round vent hole faces the front of the lamp.
3. There is an “on/off” switch located on the cord. Flip the switch.
4. To adjust the amount of light coming from your lamp, twist the lid left or right. To completely darken the lamp, twist the lid 180 degrees so the vent hole is facing the back of the lamp.

ABOUT THE BULB

The heat generated by the bulb rises and is vented out of the KosherLamp's patent-pending baffle system. A vent hole in the roof of the Lamp and an exhaust port at the front of the Lamp allows heat to escape but not any light.

Please ensure this hole is never covered.

NEW! All KosherLamp MAX manufactured after November 2016 will include one LED bulb (Light Emitting Diode). This is the most efficient bulb currently available on the market. Prior to this date, Compact Fluorescent Light (CFL) bulbs were included with the KosherLamp. Both types of bulbs are acceptable for use in your KosherLamp provided you use the included bulbs or those shown above.

INSTALLATION OF BULB

1. Remove the plug from the wall socket.
2. Remove the inner shade of your KosherLamp™ by lifting it straight up by its top. Ensure no packaging materials are left inside the cylinder from shipping.
3. Insert the bulb directly into the lamp from above. Twist the light bulb into the socket.
4. While holding the top of the inner shade, gently lower it into the outer cylinder. Take care to avoid scraping the two cylinders.

TWISTING THE SHADE OF YOUR KOSHERLAMP™


All authorities permit the twisting of the inner shade on Shabbos.

MOVING THE KOSHERLAMP™ ON SHABBOS

While twisting the upper shade to control the light is permitted, many poskim hold that the lamp itself (outer shade and base) is considered muktzah, and therefore cannot be moved. If you need its place or need to move it to change the direction of the light, it must be done with a shinui (irregular way), such as pushing it with one's elbow.
